The Kotara High School Sports Program offers its students a variety of activities, some of which require using equipment provided by an external agency on school grounds. This note also includes a commitment to pay the weekly fee.

In the event of illness or injury, I authorise the seeking of such medical assistance on my behalf that my  
child might require. I also give permission for my child to travel to and from the venue.

Before participating in an Archery Attack or Bubble Sports Activity, all participants must read the important information in this document and then sign the declaration.

Archery Attack and Bubble Sports activities are run by Archery Attack & Bubble Sports Sydney (AABS).

**You are not allowed to participate if you are**

- Under the age of 18 without a parental or guardian signature
- Under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Pregnant, or have a pre-existing medical condition that is at risk of further exacerbation by enduring intense physical activity.

1. The Participant understands that in participating in this event/activity they may suffer injury, harm, loss and the event/activity may cause injury, harm loss and damage to those taking part and the Participant does so at his/her own risk.

2. To the extent permitted by law, the Participant accepts that AABS, the venue, or event host will not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses, which may arise in consequence of participation in the event/activity.

3. The Participant shall not make any Claim or Demand against AABS or The Venue for any reason whatsoever including, but not limited to, any Claim or Demand arising as a result of any action, default, omission or negligence of AABS and to the fullest extent permitted by law the Participant accepts that the AABS or the Venue will not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses, which may arise in consequence of participation in the event/activity.

4. The Participant will at all times behave in a manner that is in accordance with the code of conduct, and hereby warrants that he/she has read the code of conduct.

5. The Participant will grant permission to AABS to use or authorise other bona fide agencies to use photographs, motion pictures, recordings, data or any other record of my participation in this event for any legitimate purpose without remuneration.

**Code of Conduct**

- All participants must listen to the AABS Representative at all times and abide by explained game rules and instructions.

**Archery Attack**

- To avoid injury, listen to instructions on correct shooting techniques and wear equipment as instructed
- Helmets must be worn at all times on the field
- Do not shoot people outside of the field or who are exiting the field after being shot

**Media Content**

- Photographs, motion pictures, video footage and electrical sound recordings will be taken through out the event and uploaded to the Archery Attack social media pages
- If there are any issues with media content being taken of you please alert a staff member straight away
